**Shoreland Protection Specialist

The Shoreland Protection Specialist is responsible for assisting with the preparation of shoreland restoration plans and related activities, developing informational and educational materials, maintaining shoreland restoration demonstration sites, and implementing the Shoreland Protection Program. This casual, limited term position is based primarily during the summer (1,000 hours maximum per calendar year). The position is funded by Langlade and Lincoln County's Lake Protection Grant as awarded by the WI DNR, and is a shared position with Lincoln County. Wage: \$14.50/hr - \$17.50/hr depending upon qualifications.

Training and experience: High School Diploma, a minimum of two years of college education and experience in environmental science, natural resources management, or education. Knowledge of Wisconsin native plant taxonomy is essential. Applicants must also be able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, with the general public and have proficient computer skills. Must possess valid Wisconsin driver's license and provide own transportation.
