2022 OUTSTANDING LAND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE MEMBER AWARD

Purpose

To recognize a Land Conservation Committee (LCC) member who has provided strong and effective leadership in promoting resource conservation through their own actions and work in their community.

Eligibility

Nominees may be any individual who is serving on their county's LCC (or equivalent) and supporting the purpose and efforts of the LCC.

Guidelines

Leadership, effectiveness and the nominee's efforts to demonstrate a commitment to conservation shall be important factors in judging this award. Length of service (except where those have been important factors in leadership and effectiveness) shall not be considered important criteria for this award. Nominations received without proper support/paperwork may not be eligible for an award.

Procedure

Entries should be submitted before December 31, 2021 to WI Land+Water, 131 West Wilson Street, Suite 601, Madison, WI 53703 or email to chris@wisconsinlandwater.org. The WI Land+Water Professional Improvement Committee will review submittals and select the winner(s) by January 25, 2022. Recognition of the State Award will be provided at the annual WI Land+Water Conference held March 2-4, 2022. The sponsoring county is responsible for travel and lodging expenses for the State Award Recipient; awards dinner banquet meal for the winner and one guest (if applicable) will be provided by WI Land+Water (two maximum).

Oscar and his wife Norma, don't only promote conservation, they practice it. They were selected as Wisconsin's Outstanding Conservation Farmers in 1995 by the Wisconsin Land and Water Conservation Association and hosted

Conservation Observance Day. Oscar was recently selected as a 2021 recipient of the Cooperative Builder Award, which honors individuals who have made outstanding contributions at the local, state, and/or national level to advance cooperative philosophy and ideals.
