DATCP- Producer-led applications are out. Preliminary SWRM #'s are available. 100% of 1st, 85% of 2nd @70%. Goal is to get it internally reviewed. ATACP 50 comment period is closed. Working on responding to comments. This fall it will go back to DATCP board. Legislature by Feb 20th.

UWEX- Line item in DNR budget that funds 4 Water Quality Educators. They are hiring 2 additional staff for PFAFs, etc. Looking for additional funding from NRCS for this fiscal year.

- 2023-2025 State Budget Overview- Matt provided an overview to the Biennial Budget. \$10,962,300 (2024), \$11,214,200 (2025). One-time funding of \$1,998,200 (2024) and \$2,250,250 (2025) with base funding of \$8.9 million.
- Legislative Overview & Update- FPP (sb134) has not advanced yet. Not sure where it goes from here. FSA bill (sb147) is on its way to Gov's Desk. Not movement on Fenwood Creek Watershed project.
