2018 CONSERVATION STEWARD AWARD

Purpose

To recognize a person(s) or entity(ies) whose outstanding work, leadership or project exemplifies dedication to the conservation and protection of Wisconsin's natural resources.

Eligibility

Nominees can be any private or public individual or organization that either through their daily work, specific project or conservation practice, and/or leadership displays an outstanding commitment or approach to land and resource management. Projects or programs displaying collaborative efforts are also encouraged.

Guidelines

Leadership and effectiveness of the nominee's efforts to demonstrate a commitment to conservation shall be important factors in judging this award. Nominations may be made by either a land conservation department staff or land conservation committee supervisor. Nominations received without proper support/paperwork may not be eligible for an award.

Procedure

Entries should be submitted before **December 31, 2017** to WI Land+Water, 131 West Wilson Street, Suite 601, Madison, WI 53703 or emailed to chris@wisconsinlandwater.org. The WI Land+Water Professional Improvement Committee will review submittals and announce the winner by January 26, 2018. Recognition of the State Award will be provided at the annual WI Land+Water Conference held March 14-16, 2018. The sponsoring county is responsible for travel and lodging expenses for the State Award Recipient; awards dinner banquet meal for the winner and one guest (if applicable) will be provided by WI Land+Water (two maximum).
