

# **TAYLOR COUNTY CONSERVATION ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN**

Taylor County is seeking a full-time Conservation Engineering Technician. Duties include planning, developing and evaluating the County's Land and Water Conservation protection programs to meet the goals and needs of Taylor County. Performs engineering analysis and computations. Creates engineered plans with CAD software, drafts contract documents, solicits and reviews bids and recommends award of construction contracts. Oversees quality control of construction materials and methods. Supervises, directs and coordinates contractor performance of construction projects. Prepares and administers the project construction budgets and grant applications.

Applicants must have either a Bachelor's or Associate's Degree in Agricultural, Civil or Environmental Engineering, Soil and Water Conservation, or related engineering or conservation field, or certification as an Engineer-in-Training, and two years of work experience in soil and water conservation practices and survey design; or any combination of education and experience that provides the necessary knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the duties of the job. It is preferred the applicant have a Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System [POWTS] Inspector license and a certified soil tester license. A valid driver's license is required.
