Overall Purpose/Summary:

Under general direction of the County Conservationist, makes landowner contacts to promote conservation practices and provide technical assistance for a variety of conservation programs administered by the Land and Water Conservation Department. These programs include but are not limited to, Land and Water Resource Management, Farmland Preservation, Dodge County's Animal Waste Storage Ordinance, Livestock Siting, and other State and Federal programs.

Education and Experience:

Two (2) year Associate Degree in agriculture engineering, natural resource management, soils, hydrology, environmental science or other related natural science field in required, a four (4) year Bachelor's degree is preferred. A minimum of three (3) years' experience in soil erosion and water abatement practices, proven competency in planning, design, and construction inspection of soil erosion control and water pollution practices is preferred. An Equivalent combination of education and experience which provides the necessary knowledge, skills and abilities may be considered.

Other Requirements:

- Knowledge of conservation practices, standards and regulations for the protection of surface and groundwater resources.
- Knowledge of agricultural practices and factors that can have a negative effect on water quality.
- Ability to identify resource concerns and identify conservation practices that can be implemented to improve water quality.
- Thorough knowledge of agricultural operations and acceptable soil erosion control and water pollution abatement practices.
- Ability to become proficient at using computer programs including GIS mapping, Snap Plus and CAD.
- Knowledge of farm programs and cost share programs available to assist landowners and operators with projects and practices.
- Knowledge of land surveying for engineering practice design.
- Must meet requirements of Dodge County Driver Qualification Policy.
